Dear Ms. President of the European Commission, Ursula Von Der Leyen

75 years ago, a catastrophe was facilitated by Europe, creating a new occupying state in the heart of the Middle East, while the Palestinian people had a dream of freedom promised by the British colonisers.

The new apartheid state of occupation in Palestine was not freedom for Palestinian people who were evacuated and uprooted from their land where more than 531 cities, villages, localities were demolished and levelled to the ground.

The occupation generated seven million refugees. We trust that you witnessed these life stories during your visit to The Holly Land in the last year.

You are aware that more than 100000 Palestinians were killed, including women, children, and elderly.

That more than a million Palestinian prisoners were in the Israeli jails, some of them died and their bodies were never returned by Israel.

Tenths of thousand's of houses, schools, hospitals, and media centres were destroyed by the Israeli soldiers including Euro-Israeli citizens who participate in these crimes of the army of occupation's state.

We are Euro-Palestinians sharing with you the same values:

Freedom for all, stopping all the wars, criminalizing all forms of persecution and crimes against humanity, and confiscating their right to self-determination.
